## Seminole Wars in Dunedin

The Dunedin Historical Society Museum will feature one of the most turbulent periods in Florida's history from July 7th to December 31st. "Seminole Wars: The Fight For Florida," recounts the first half of the 19th century, when Florida resembled a battlefield, as the Seminole Indians and America fought for the same land. The interactive exhibit allows visitors to visit a fort, fill a military supply wagon, try on army uniforms, test the weight of a soldier's backpack, and even listen to "soldiers" discussing their war experiences.
